The only way a person can prove Proof of Service is through certification by signature through postal clerk.This process is not required by South Carolina AppellateCourt Rules.

Mr. Washington Parks located on 185 South Liberty street business and tax accountant is my witness. The proof of service was mailed to Boulter Thompson Barnes and Vic Bailey 111, attorney of record on September 24th,2024, U.S. Main Postal Service ,Spartanburg South Carolina, at 250 South Church street. and Spartanburg County Clerk of Court at 180 Magnolia Street, Second floor suite 500, Spartanburg, South Carolina, 29306

I personally went to the main post office at 250 South Church Street, Spartanburg, South Carolina and talked with the front desk postal clerk to explain this situation and ask how the mail runs. The postal representative explain to me, "The week in question was due to HURRICANE HELENE week of September 22nd, 2024 through October 7th, 2024"any mail deposited would have been subject to severe delay because the upstate were under a State of Emergency by Governor McMaster due to power outages and trees and power lines down Statewide. Also they stated, they have witness mail late for months after a serious aftermath like Helene, and the courthouse and attorneys still might get it, mail have been in some cases months behind due too bad stormy weather.

P.S.Emily was my assigned case handler. I had concerns regarding the process being handle correctly. She and I went through all the filings at that point in detail. My check was sent for 300.00 Not 250.00. When I resent the fee, I was told to do the proof of service and filings at same time is where the confusion , along with correcting check amount from 300.00 to 250.00. called several times, finally on October 30th,2024 and October 31st,2024 and No answer then talked with representative, Kaitlyn. who noted my case regarding questions I had concerns regarding Filings.

The deadline was September 28th. mail out Proof of Service 24th,2024
