ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals sent the remittitur in this case on October 21, 2024, after Petitioner failed to serve and file a timely petition for a writ of certiorari with this Court. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction in this matter. *Stogsdill v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Human Servs.*, 415 S.C. 568, 784 S.E.2d 669 (2016); *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007). Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.¹
