Judge Amy McCullough, violated my rights, acted unethically and unprofessionally when she signed an order on October 26, 2023 To have me involuntarily committed to the VA Hospital for a 24-hour mental evaluation which lasted for 21 days.

I was physically assaulted by my uncle Raymond that day and called 911. After a conversation with Blythewood deputies regarding the assault, my plans to protest against police, the probate court, contact ACLU + Rev. A. Sharpton re: a targeting + ticketing incident. I was

old Judge McCullough ordered a 24-hour mental evaluation, was handcuffed, thrown into the back of the police car + taken to the VA hospital psych ward where I spent a horrifying 21 days. I also believe this was done in an effort to keep me from having any influence over my father's estate, to make me ^{look} incompetent and incapable of handling any business dealing with my father's estate, to attempt to get me to sign over power of attorney to my sister so she could handle my affairs, retaliation for ODC complaint against Judge Beeton + probate court, to keep me from protesting outside the courthouse, which I did after I was released, to try and make me look mentally unstable and defame my character. Although I have forgiven her for the harm her

actions caused me, I believe she must be held accountable. I do not believe she would be or could be unbiased when rendering a decision regarding my father's estate. especially after I requested that she be disbarred. I am requesting that she be investigated, that she be recused or that there be a change in venue.
