MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Brandan Lamont Richardson respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from December 3, 2024 until January 2, 2025**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Brandan Lamont Richardson respectfully submits that extraordinary

circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Dante Zachius Wheeler v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 20, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Steve Lester with this Court on November 20, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Brian Foster v. The State with this Court on November 14, 2024. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of James L. Williford with the Supreme Court on November 5, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Felicia Danielle Turnage with this Court on November 1, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Vincent Dwight with this Court on October 30, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Wayne Hankinson v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 28, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Kweisi Nicks with this Court on October 4, 2024. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Bradley Corlew before this Court on September 24, 2024.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload

will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




