MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE DESIGNATION OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN THE RECORD ON APPEAL

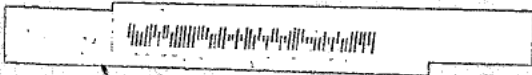
