MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions


previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of David R. Brown v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 25, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Ansel B. Wallen v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 25, 2024. Counsel filed the Amended Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Amended Supplemental Appendix in the case of The State v. Carnie Norris with the Supreme Court on September 18, 2024.






