MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions


previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of State v. Darrell D. Wilson with the Court of Appeals on November 21, 2024. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Philip Miller with the Court of Appeals on November 20, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Ronald Michaux v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 18, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Clyde Singletary v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 12, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Akeem Hampton with the Court of Appeals on November 6, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Akeem Hickman with the Court of Appeals on October 31, 2024. Counsel attended the annual South Carolina Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina from October 14-16, 2024.






