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**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE/SERVE REPLY BRIEF**

NOW COMES Petitioner City of Charleston (the “City”) by and through its undersigned counsel, on the grounds stated below, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and hereby moves for an extension of ten (10) days’ time to file/serve its reply brief as provided by Rule 242(i), SCACR.
