Notice of Nonlawyer Rights

I, Cynthia-J: Glenn™, a living woman, agent for CYNTHIA GLENN, the registered agent for the dissolved CYNTHIA GLENN LLC which was the registered agent for the dissolved Carolina Birth Center LLC, have petitioned the court Sui Juris and have full power to act in the same manner as the principle. Having given notice as Agent/Attorney in-fact or next friend, for Lawful Counsel, acting on behalf of the Principles come now to give further notice that I retain all rights afforded to nonlawyer representatives.

1. Conley v. Gibson, 355 U.S. 41 at 48 (1957). "Following the simple guide of rule 8(f) that all pleadings shall be so construed as to do substantial justice"... "The federal rules reject the approach that pleading is a game of skill in which one misstep by counsel may be decisive to the outcome and accept the principle that the purpose of pleading is to facilitate a proper decision on the merits." The court also cited Rule 8(f) FRCP, which holds that all pleadings shall be construed to do substantial justice. And SCRCF Rule 8(f) Construction of Pleadings. All pleadings shall be so construed as to do substantial justice to all parties.

2. Haines v. Kerner, 404 U.S. 519 (1972). "Allegations such as those asserted by petitioner, however inartfully pleaded, are sufficient"... "which we hold to less stringent standards than formal pleadings drafted by lawyers.

3. Maty v. Grasselli Chemical Co., 303 U.S. 197 (1938), "Pleadings are intended to serve as a means of arriving at fair and just settlements of controversies between litigants... They should not raise barriers which prevent the achievement of that end. Proper pleading is important, but its importance consists in its effectiveness as a means to accomplish the end of a just judgment."

4. NAACP v. Button, 371 U.S. 415); United Mineworkers of America v. Gibbs, 383 U.S.715; and Johnson v. Avery, 89 S. Ct. 747 (1969) Members of groups who are competent nonlawyers can assist

other members of the group achieve the goals of the group in court without being charged with "unauthorized practice of law."

5. Sherar v. Cullen, 481 F. 2d 946 (1973) "There can be no sanction or penalty imposed upon one because of his exercise of Constitutional Rights."

6. Boyd v. United, 116 U.S. 616 at 635 (1885) Justice Bradley, "It may be that it is the obnoxious thing in its mildest form; but illegitimate and unconstitutional practices get their first footing in that way; namely, by silent approaches and slight deviations from legal modes of procedure. This can only be obviated by adhering to the rule that constitutional provisions for the security of persons and property should be liberally construed. A close and literal construction deprives them of half their efficacy, and leads to gradual depreciation of the right, as if it consisted more in sound than in substance. It is the duty of the Courts to be watchful for the Constitutional Rights of the Citizens, and against any stealthy encroachments thereon. Their motto should be Obsta Principiis."

7. Juliard v. Greeman, 110 U.S. 421 (1884) Supreme Court Justice Field, "There is no such thing as a power of inherent sovereignty in the government of the United States... In this country, sovereignty resides in the people, and Congress can exercise power which they have not, by their Constitution, entrusted to it. All else is withheld."

8. Miranda v. Arizona, 384 U.S. 426, 491; 86 S. Ct. 1603 "Where rights secured by the Constitution are involved, there can be no 'rule making' or legislation which would abrogate them."

Dear Ms. Garrett,

This is a request for access to the public records listed below pursuant to the S.C. Freedom of Information Act, SC Code 30-4-10, et seq. Whereas court files are public records and anyone who makes a proper request to view or copy court files should be allowed to do so. Court recordings are not a proper exemption within the guidelines and this request does not violate federal or state privacy acts.

The South Carolina Supreme Court has repeatedly stated that the "FOIA creates an affirmative duty on the part of public bodies to disclose information. The purpose of the Act is to protect the public by providing for disclosure of information." *Bellamy v. Brown*; see also *Campbell v. Marion County Hospt. Dist*, *Burton v. York City. Sheriff's Dep't*. To achieve these purposes, the General Assembly provided that "[a]ny person has a right to inspect or copy any public record of a public body, except as otherwise provided by 30-4-40, in accordance with reasonable rules concerning time and place of access." Additionally, Attorney General Alan Wilson's opinion dated April 5, 2017 regarded audio tape recordings of a public body (such as the GREENVILLE COUNTY COURT) to be public record and therefore subject to disclosure under FOIA.

I am hereby requesting a copy of the webEx recording as well as any other video or audio recordings regarding the cases 2024LP2300640 and 2022CP2301799, *Fisher v. Glenn*, held in the presence of Alex Kinlaw on October 8, 2024. I can be reached by telephone at 864-350-2830 to schedule a time to retrieve the records.

If there is a charge for providing me access, please advise me of your estimate of the charge and its basis when you contact me to arrange access. I am happy to provide a usb or other storage device if necessary.

I look forward to hearing from you within the time limits set by the law.
