On Tuesday, October 22, 2024, at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held for judgment summary on the car loan from Founders' Federal Credit Union that resulted in repossession of a vehicle with judgment being granted for the amount of \$14,929.63. I received a written notice of this judgment for case number 2023-CP-42-02216 by mail on November, 15th 2024 .
