


## ORDER

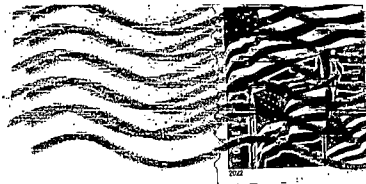
