MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Brandon Wilson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of

3. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Willie M. Williams v. The State before the Court of Appeals on December 5, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Terrance Seabrook v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 25, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter and record on appeal in the case of Toya Steward The State v. Toya Danielle Steward with the Court of Appeals on November 22, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Francisco Rodriguez with the Supreme Court on November 21, 2024. Counsel filed the reply brief of petitioner in the case of Maurio D. Rivers v. The State with the Court of Appeals on November 7, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Alexander Rhue, Jr. with the Supreme Court on November 6, 2024. Counsel filed the brief of respondent in the case of Angelo H. Taylor v. The State with the Court of Appeals on October 23, 2024. Counsel filed the reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Stepheno Alston v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 17, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of Dennis Cumbee v. The State with the Court of Appeals on October 17, 2024. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Francisco Maldonado-Molina with the Court of Appeals on October 7, 2024. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Larry King with the Court of Appeals on September 30, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty-day general consent granted by email from Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka dated November 27, 2024 for all Appellate Defense extensions through December 31, 2024.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension in which to serve and file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
