Dear Clerks Kitchings and Harrison,

This letter is sent in accordance with the requirements of S.C. App. Ct. Rule 207(a)(2),(a)(5). I have not received a transcript from an official court reporter because Ms. Holmes has apparently not assigned the transcript to an official SC Judicial System Court Reporter. Appellant ordered the transcript in a timely manner pursuant to SCAC Rule 207(a). Please see the enclosed letters and documents sent to Court Reporter Manager Tammie Holmes.

Recorded with the Appellate Court on October 7, 2024, was a new appeal on the Horry County Case No. 2020CP2605267. With this new appeal, a new transcript is required. That transcript was ordered by the SCCA Form 800 and the letter of October 10, 2024.

As you can see from my letter of December 10, 2024, to Ms. Holmes, there has been no follow-up to that letter and request from her nor anyone else. I have received

- (1) no contact from an SC Official Court Reporter employed by the SC Judicial System,
- (2) no written answer to my letter to her (Exhibit 1),
- (3) no email from her regarding my letter of October 10, 2024. A copy of my email page pulling up all email correspondence with her shows that the last email was July 26, 2024, Exhibit 2.

According to the South Carolina Judicial Website, Ms. Holmes is still employed as the Manager of Court Reporters for the SC Judicial System. Her responsibility as described on that website is to assign court reporters to transcript orders. Enclosed is a copy of the website page with her name and job description, Exhibit 3.

The letter of October 10, 2024, requested that an official South Carolina Court Reporter employed by the state judicial system to complete the transcript of the WEBEX hearing of July 24, 2024, 1:30 p.m. docket before Judge B. Alex Hyman.

Today, with this letter I am making a second request that Ms. Holmes assign an official State of South Carolina court reporter who is employed by the SC Judicial System. A court reporter has 60 days to complete a transcript after the transcript has been assigned. As of today, there is no record of her assigning this to an official SC Court Reporter. There is no justification for her failure to assign this to an official court reporter. If there was justification, it is her responsibility to report that to me by letter or email. Refusing to assign the transcript as requested, is obstruction of justice.

This transcript was previously requested. It was sent to an e-service called Legal Eagles managed by a Kevin Dehlinger. I received a horrendous mess of a transcript from them by email. It appeared that the person who typed it had English as a foreign language. It took me 14 hours to figure out what it said. It was a 25 page transcript. Enclosed in Ms. Holmes letter is a copy of that pathetic (unreadable) transcript. It appears to have been transcribed by someone who has learned English as a foreign language and has no familiarity with the terminology of the court.

Please work with Ms. Holmes to meet the requirements of SCAC Rule 207.

Dear Ms. Holmes,

Recorded with the Appellate Court on October 7, 2024, was a new appeal on the Horry County Case No. 2020CP2605267. With this new appeal, a new transcript is required. That transcript was ordered by a letter to you of October 10, 2024, and included Form 800 of the SCCA. See Exhibit 1.

There has been no follow-up to that letter and request from you nor anyone else. I have received

- (1)no contact from an SC Official Court Reporter employed by the SC Judicial System,
- (2)no written answer to my letter from you (Exhibit 1),
- (3)no email from you regarding my letter to you of October 10, 2024. A copy of my email page pulling up all email correspondence with you shows that the last email from you was July 26, 2024, Exhibit 2.

According to the South Carolina Judicial Website, you are still employed as the Manager of Court Reporters for the SC Judicial System. Your responsibility as described on that website is to assign court reporters to transcript orders. Enclosed is a copy of the website page with your name and job description, Exhibit 3.

The letter of October 10, 2024 requested that an official South Carolina Court Reporter employed by the state judicial system to complete the transcript of the WEBEX hearing of July 24, 2024, 1:30 p.m. docket before Judge B. Alex Hyman.

Today, with this letter I am making a second request that you assign an official State of South Carolina court reporter who is employed by the SC Judicial System. A court reporter has 60 days to complete a transcript after the transcript has been assigned. As of today, there is no record of your assigning this to an official SC Court Reporter. There is no justification for your failure to assign this to an official court reporter. If there was justification, it is your responsibility to report that to me by letter or email. Refusing to assign the transcript as requested, is obstruction of justice.

This transcript was previously requested. It was sent to an e-service called Legal Eagles managed by a Kevin Dehlinger. I received a horrendous mess of a transcript from them by email. It appeared that the person who typed it had English as a foreign language. It took me 14 hours to figure out what it said. It was a 25 page transcript. Enclosed is a copy of that pathetic transcript. Please read this transcript so that you become aware of the defects present in this transcript and in the work of this service. After you read it, you may agree with me that it appears to have been transcribed by someone who has learned English as a foreign language and has no familiarity with the terminology of the court. Please provide your assessment of the accuracy of this transcript. Can you understand what happened in court based on this transcript?

An appeal requires a transcript. The transcript is evidence for the hearing and the evidence of documents presented in the hearing. A defective transcript destroys the evidence. It is illegal to destroy case evidence.

Please inform me of the procedures you have taken to remove this e-service from SC Court transcript assignments. Parties who are assigned to this service are cheated out of time, out of their funds, and out of justice. In my appeal, as an example, assigning a defective transcription service to my transcript constitutes obstruction of justice. Your refusal to assign an official court reporter, and your refusal to correspond with me about these requests additionally contribute to obstruction of justice.

Please contact me regarding your plan for correcting this violation of court procedures.

Obtain a Transcript

HOW DO I OBTAIN A TRANSCRIPT?

Anyone who is a party or an attorney interested in obtaining a transcript from a court proceeding in Circuit or Family Court must order the transcript in writing by contacting the court reporter assigned to record the proceedings and copying transcripts@sccourts.org. You may request a transcript by completing this **form** and emailing it to South Carolina Court Administration at transcripts@sccourts.org and to the Court Reporter.

In your letter, you must provide the exact date of the proceeding, the name of the judge, the county where the proceeding was heard, and the name of the case. If you are requesting a transcript from court proceedings in Municipal, Magistrate, Master-In-Equity, or Probate court, you must contact that court directly.

In order to determine who the court reporter was for a Circuit or Family Court hearing, you may click on the **Judicial Branch calendar**, which lists the terms of court. There you will find every Family and Circuit court term from January 2002 to the present. Once you have located the term of court, county, and the judge who presided, you will see the court reporter's name listed. Clicking on the blue link will bring up the mailing address. You

may contact the court reporter directly using this address. If you do not have access to the Internet, you may contact the Office of Court Administration to determine who the court reporter was that recorded the proceedings. Once your request is received, court reporters should acknowledge your request in writing within five days, advising you of the cost to obtain the transcript. Court reporters do not accept personal checks. You will be instructed to send a money order or certified bank check in order to obtain the transcript.

Pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court **Rule 607**, court reporters have 60 days to prepare and deliver the transcript after satisfactory payment arrangements are made. If the court reporter is unable to complete the transcript in 60 days, he or she may request a 30-day extension. If this extension is granted, you will be notified by Court Administration. Court reporters may ask for up to three extensions from Court Administration. If court reporters are unable, due to heavy transcript loads, time in court, or other extenuating circumstances, to produce the transcript within that additional 90-day time frame, they may request an additional extension from the Chief Justice. If granted, you will be notified by Court Administration.

If after following this procedure, your request is not acknowledged, or the transcript has not been received, you may contact Court Administration, and we will be glad to assist you. If you are requesting a transcript from court proceedings, contact Tammie Holmes, Court Reporter Manager, via email: tholmes@sccourts.org, or if you prefer, at South Carolina Court Administration, 1220 Senate Street, Suite 200, Columbia, SC 29201.
