On behalf of Petitioner Amazon Services LLC (“Petitioner”), we respectfully request a 15-day extension of time to file Petitioner’s Reply Brief in the above matter. Petitioner requests this extension due to counsel’s time constraints for personal and work obligations as well as the approaching holidays.
