I, Philip Keathe Carey, do solemnly swear, verify, and acknowledge by signature that the statements and facts contained within this document are true, correct, and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.

I, Philip Keathe Carey, hereinafter Appellant, do move this Honorable Court to release, remove, and dismiss Appellate Defender David Alexander from Appellate Case No. 2012-212575 and move to pursue Appellate Case No. 2012-212575 pro se. The Motion established by Appellant will continue and/or remain in effect ab initio and be filed immediately upon reviewing. All discussions in MOTION FOR REMEDY AND VACATION OF SENTENCE shall remain in effect, as the dismissal and removal of Appellate Defender David Alexander shall not limit, hinder, or cause suffering of herein mentioned MOTION FOR REMEDY AND VACATION OF SENTENCE.


Further, upon receipt of this agreement, a notice shall be delivered/mailed of acceptance (See U.C.C. § 3-410, U.C.C. § 2-606.) to dismiss and remove Mr. David Alexander as Appellate Defender over Appellate Case No. 2012-212575, as Appellant will file pro se from this point forward. Appellate Defender David Alexander is a hinderance to Appellate Case No. 2012-212575 and shall be removed from the herein mentioned case immediately upon receipt of this agreement.

According to a letter filed with the Office of Disciplinary Counsel and a response made on June 18, 2013 by Staff Attorney (See Black's Law Dictionary 8th ed.) Tiffany N. Richardson, not having the capacity nor the authority to make decisions concerning the dismissal and/or removal of lawyers or otherwise.

Therefore, if Appellant is not informed of the termination of Appellate Defender David Alexander and notice is not given to Appellant of viewing of the herein mentioned MOTION FOR REMEDY AND VACATION OF SENTENCE, an ensuing fee of FIVE MILLION UNITED STATES DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00) shall be paid to Appellant for failure to act and acknowledge the relief sought in the MOTION FOR REMEDY AND VACATION OF SENTENCE, Article III. Due to the expiration of the thirty (30) day period granted within the MOTION FOR REMEDY AND VACATION OF SENTENCE an additional fee of SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND UNITED STATES DOLLARS (\$750,000.00) will incur, as well as the relief sought in same Motion. The additional fee shall be paid in full within ten (10) days upon receipt of this agreement. If this fee is not paid in full at the expiration of the ten (10) day grace period an Acceleration Clause (See Corbin, Contracts § 950 (1952); also see U.C.C. § 1-208.) will go into effect and a compensation fee of FIFTY MILLION UNITED STATES DOLLARS (\$50,000,000.00) shall be paid to Appellant, as this binding agreement shall go into effect immediately upon receipt.


