I represent the Appellant in the above referenced appeal. The Appellant is in the process of collecting the material designated for inclusion in the record on Appeal as set forth in the Respondent's Amended Initial Brief, but some of the materials the Respondent has designated to be included were not part of the trial transcript previously obtained, therefore necessitating that some additional requests be sent for those records.
