ORDER

We dismissed this appeal on August 21, 2024. No timely motion to reinstate was received and the remittitur was sent on September 11, 2024. Counsel for Appellant has now filed a motion to recall the remittitur, indicating the State does not object to the request. The State has not filed a return. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that the remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). After careful consideration, we grant the motion to recall remittitur and reinstate the appeal. Appellant shall provide proof he has ordered the transcript as required by Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules within ten days of the date of this order. Failure to do so may result in dismissal of this appeal.
