

Comes now Appellant respectfully request a 30-day extension of time to pay the filing fee in the above-referenced appellate matter beyond the 10 day required time to correct deficiency, as permitted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Additionally, Appellant understand that any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.

The court issued its order on December 18, 2024. However, Appellant did not receive notice by mail until December 23, 2024. Due to the proximity of the Christmas holiday, including Christmas Eve and Christmas Day on December 24 and 25, 2024, and Kwanzaa holiday of Thu, December 26, 2024 - Wed, Jan 1, 2025, Appellant have encountered delays in meeting the filing fee deadline. These circumstances have hindered his ability to comply promptly.
