ORDER


On November 26, 2024, this court dismissed this appeal due to an insufficient basis to allow the appeal of a guilty plea to proceed. *See* Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. On December 2, 2024, this court received an explanation from Appellant providing the reasons he believed his appeal should be allowed to proceed. We construe Appellant's explanation as a petition for rehearing.
