MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Michael Avery Humphrey respectfully requests an extension of **thirty (30) days until July 9, 2012** in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case. **Counsel will file the brief with this Court if at all possible earlier than the thirty (30) day extension requested.** This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a seventh request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

Counsel had requested a prior extension he intended to be the last; however, due to the current caseload, and counsel is attending the Supreme Court Advocacy Institute training program today in New York, New York.
2. Counsel for Mr. Humphrey respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. As indicated by signature below, Salley W. Elliott, of the South Carolina Attorney General's Office, does not oppose this request.


