ORDER


On July 12, 2024, this court granted Appellant's motion to hold his appeal in abeyance for ninety days. According to the terms of this court's order, Appellant was directed to serve and file the amended record on appeal "[a]t the conclusion of this ninety-day period." When Appellant failed to serve and file his amended record on appeal, this court dismissed the appeal on October 25, 2024. On November 5, 2024, Appellant filed a petition for rehearing, stating that the order granting his motion to hold the appeal in abeyance "did not say after the [ninety] days how many days [he] would have to file" the amended record on appeal. After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.
