
## ORDER

---

On September 9, 2024, this court issued an order taking no action on Appellant's motion for reconsideration of this court's July 26, 2024 letter. On September 19, 2024, Appellant filed a motion for clarification of this court's September 9, 2024 order, a motion for reconsideration, and, if denied, a petition for rehearing. We construe Appellant's motion as a petition for rehearing. After careful consideration, we take no action on the petition for rehearing. *See* Rule 221(c), SCACR ("The appellate court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal."); *Methods of Electronic Filing and Service Under Rule 262 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules*, para. (d)(2), S.C. Sup. Ct. Order (as amended Apr. 24, 2024) ("An appellate court may send an order, opinion[,] or other correspondence to a lawyer admitted to practice law in South Carolina using that lawyer's primary e-mail address in AIS."); *In re Collie*, 406 S.C. 181, 186, 749 S.E.2d 522, 524-25 (2013) (placing a lawyer on interim suspension for her "persistent refusal to comply with [the supreme c]ourt's directives," including failure to maintain and monitor an operational email account); Rule 260(a), SCACR ("Whenever it appears that an appellant or a petitioner has failed to comply with the requirements of these Rules, the clerk shall issue an order of dismissal, which shall have the same force and effect as an order of the appellate court."). We deny Appellant's request for a refund of the filing fee accompanying her June 17, 2024 motion. *See* Rule 240(d), SCACR ("The motion

or petition filed with the appellate court shall be accompanied by the filing fee set by order of the [s]upreme [c]ourt.").

Finally, we deny Appellant's motion to correct the docket as moot. The docket entry Appellant claimed was missing appears on c-track. *See Sloan v. Dep't of Transp.*, 379 S.C. 160, 167, 666 S.E.2d 236, 240 (2008) (holding that generally, this court "will not pass on moot and academic questions or make an adjudication where there remains no actual controversy").
