



## ORDER

---

Respondents have filed a motion to dismiss, arguing Appellant has consistently failed to adhere to filing deadlines, consistently failed to serve all parties with copies of documents filed with this court, and misled this court regarding his reasons for failing to comply with deadlines and failing to serve all parties. Appellant filed a return in opposition, and Respondents filed a reply. After careful consideration, Respondents' motion to dismiss is denied. However, Appellant shall adhere to all filing deadlines and shall serve Respondents with all filed documents as required by the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. *See e.g.* Rule 240(d), SCACR ("The motion or petition shall be filed with the clerk of the appellate court, and a copy shall be served upon each party."); Rule 208(a)(1), SCACR ("Within thirty (30) days after receiving the transcript or, if no transcript is ordered, within thirty (30) days after serving the notice of appeal, appellant shall serve one copy of his brief on all parties to the appeal . . ."); Rule 211(a), SCACR ("Within twenty (20) days after the service of the Record on Appeal, each party shall serve a copy of the party's final brief(s) on every other party to the appeal, and file the final brief(s) with the clerk of the appellate court."). Failure to adhere to the filing deadlines and serve Respondents as required under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules will result in the dismissal of the appeal.

After careful consideration, Respondents' alternative request for sanctions is denied.
