Good Morning,

I have been receiving correspondence from the SC Court of Appeals regarding this appellate matter and wanted to request how to clear up an error. I am not involved in the Appeal filed by Mr. Gallipeau.

The appeal from the Magistrate's Court that Mr. Gallipeau filed in Lexington County Circuit Court contained what were new allegations against DP Marine. While I did appear on the responsive pleading filed, I appeared only as "Attorney for Defendants" with regards to the Answer to the new allegations.
