STATEMENT OF CASE

Plaintiff, now Appellant attempted to file a Civil Action specifically for Legal Malpractice, Outrage, and Civil Conspiracy primarily against an attorney respecting a case Appellant initially fil[ed] [and] litigated Pro Se. Appellant encloses certificate of his Indigent status, See Attachment A.

The circuit court clerk's office advised Appellant to resubmit his suit and provided him with an informa Pauperis form. Appellant promptly complied and resubmitted his lawsuit with supporting Attachments. He specifically re-included the required Financial Report through SCDC according to §24-27-100 & 150 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (2007).

Appellant timely appealed. The Court of Appeals initially refused to hear this appeal challenging Appellant's wrongful conviction. Appellant responded explaining his indigent plight re-emphasizing material facts underlying principles of law that he has, as a certified indigent person was entitled to Access the Courts to A) challenge his wrongful conviction and B) to challenge improper conditions of confinement.

The Appeals Court ultimately heard and denied the case. Appellant filed for Petition for Rehearing. Again, the Court of Appeals demanded a \$25.00 Motion fee, again rejecting his appeal. Appellant responded.

Subsequently, the Court of Appeals issued the inclosed order denying the petition for rehearing. Attachment B

This timely Petition for Writ of Certiorari follows.

QUESTION PRESENTED

I. IS APPELLANT IN FACT ENTITLED ACCESS IN STATE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS AS A CERTIFIED INDIGENT PLAINTIFF TO CHALLENGE HIS (W)RONGFUL CONVICTION IMPROPER CONDITIONS OF CONFINEMENT, AND OTHER LEGITIMATE VIOLATIONS OF STATE TORT LAW?

CONCLUSION


PETITIONER SHOULD NOT BE DELAYED..... OR DEPRIVED AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD OR OTHERWISE GAIN ACCESS WITHIN STATE CIRCUIT COURTS, NOW AS A CERTIFIED THOROUGHLY INDIGENT PERSON AFTER THIRTEEN (13) CONTINUOUS YEARS OF INCARCERATION.

THE CAPTIONED CASE SHOULD BE CLOCKED-IN BY A LOWER JURISDICTIONAL CIRCUIT COURT WHEREWITH HE MAY PROMPTLY MAKE SERVICE UPON DEFENDANTS.

FURTHER, THE APPEALS COURT SHOULD TOLL ANY QUESTIONABLE STATUE OF LIMITATIONS DEFENSE DEFENDANTS MAY ARGUE, MINUS THE TIME THIS CASE WAS INITIALLY, REPEATEDLY ATEMPTED TO BE FILED TO THE PRESENT.






