STATUS UPDATE NON RECEIPT OF TRANSCRIPT

The appellant respectfully submits this update on the status of the receipt for the transcript in case number 2024-1626 which is made within 10 days of the request made on December 13, 2024 via email. The Transcript has not yet been received; however, court administration is aware of the delay because the original transcriptionist is no longer transcribing and a new transcriptionist had to be assigned in early November. The transcript

request was copied to transcripts@courtadministration when originally ordered.

Unlike attorneys, transcriptionists do not begin work on the transcripts for *pro se* litigants until the check is received.¹

The appellant requested the transcript at the time of filing the Notice of Appeal and copied court administration at transcripts@courtadministration.com. When no communication was received within 3 weeks the appellant further contacted court administration to learn that Ms. Harris is not transcribing and the case was assigned to Ms. Crystal Banks in early November. I recently followed up with the transcriptionist, Ms. Banks to see when she anticipated completing the transcript and she wrote according to her work load, it should be complete in the next few weeks. Delays related to assignment of the new transcriptionist, the requirement that the check be received before work beginning, and Thanksgiving holiday travel contributed to the delay in receipt of payment. I do not have an exact date for receipt of the transcript.
