Counsel for Tiffany Rebecca Owens respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension from January 13, 2025 until February 12, 2025 in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Darius G. Dickey with the Court of Appeals on January 3, 2025. Counsel filed


the *Johnson* Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Courtney E. Brock v. State with the Supreme Court on December 3, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Kevin Lawrence Pearson v. State with the Supreme Court on November 21, 2024. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Wanda Jane Crumpton with the Supreme Court on November 18, 2024.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. On December 31, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 31, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension from January 13, 2025 until February 12, 2025. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


