The entire body of the letter of 12/19/2024 written by Clerk Kitchings consists of the following one paragraph, copied here:

Upon further review of our records, we note Henrietta Golding was relieved as counsel of record on May 14, 2024. All further correspondence must be copied on Richard F. Williams, as agent for Respondent. We would like to remind Respondent that it must be represented by a lawyer licensed to practice law if it wishes to participate in the appeal.

A copy of this letter is attached and labeled as **Exhibit 2**.

Appellant requests the following clarifications:

1. Correspondence - Outgoing (Court's Response to Correspondence - Incoming

Does this "Incoming Correspondence" refer to Appellant's letter to Clerks Kitchings and Harrison dated December 10, 2024, and stamped "Received on Dec 16 2024"?

Enclosed is a copy of Appellant's Letter of December 10, 2024, letter, labeled **Exhibit 3**. **There is nothing in Clerk Kitchings' letter of December 19, 2024, that is a response to any of the requests made by the Appellant in the letter of December 10, 2024.**

2. Does "(Related to Court's Deficiency Letter - Deficiency Letter Sent . . ." refer to the Harrison's letter of 12/12/2024, on ACMS line **12/12/2024 Correspondence - Outgoing (Transcript Overdue Letter)**? A copy of this letter is attached. This letter did not use the word "Deficiency," it did not mention "Proof of Service, Order," nor did it use the phrase "Transcript Overdue." Enclosed is a copy of that letter, labeled Exhibit 4.

3. What does (**Proof of Service, Order**) refer to? There is nothing in the Clerks' letters of December 12, and December 19, 2024, Exhibits 2 and 4, that refers to "Proof of Service" or "Order"?

4. It appears that the phrase of the ACMS line of December 19, 2024, is the part noted as "**and Respondent's Counsel**)". Should this indicate "Former Counsel"? **This is the only phrase on the ACMS line/date 12/19/2024 that matches the document entered with it, Kitchings letter of 12/19/2024.**

5. Clerk Kitching's letter states, "Henrietta Golding was relieved as counsel of record on May14, 2024."

Please explain why Henrietta Golding is listed on this case as "Attorney (Former)" when she was relieved five months before this case was filed. Please explain why Ms. Golding is being copied in on letters from the Clerks and Court.

What are the statutory requirements and the Appellate Court regulations placed on the Appellant to report and/or "copy-in" Ms. Golding?

6. Therefore, based on the above phrases in the ACMS Notation, line/date 12/19/2024, and on the Appellant's letters of December 10, December 22, and the current letter, **please state what, if anything, has the Appellant overlooked and needs to correct?**

7. Please respond to the requests made in Appellant's letters of December 10, 2024, December 22, 2024, and this letter, December 27, 2024, to Clerks Kitchings and Harrison.

8. Please note, that in all correspondence of the Appellant, the Respondent, 25th Avenue LLC. has been copied in since Ms. Golding was relieved on May 14, 2024.

Dear Clerks Kitchings and Harrison,

This letter is sent in accordance with the requirements of S.C. App. Ct. Rule 207(a)(2), (a)(5). I have not received a transcript from an official court reporter because Ms. Holmes has apparently not assigned the transcript to an official SC Judicial System Court Reporter. Appellant ordered the transcript in a timely manner pursuant to SCAC Rule 207(a). Please see the enclosed letters and documents sent to Court Reporter Manager Tammie Holmes.

Recorded with the Appellate Court on October 7, 2024, was a new appeal on the Horry County Case No. 2020CP2605267. With this new appeal, a new transcript is required. That transcript was ordered by the SCCA Form 800 and the letter of October 10, 2024.

As you can see from my letter of December 10, 2024, to Ms. Holmes, there has been no follow-up to that letter and request from her nor anyone else. I have received

- (1) no contact from an SC Official Court Reporter employed by the SC Judicial System,
- (2) no written answer to my letter to her (Exhibit 1),
- (3) no email from her regarding my letter of October 10, 2024. A copy of my email page pulling up all email correspondence with her shows that the last email was July 26, 2024, Exhibit 2.

According to the South Carolina Judicial Website, Ms. Holmes is still employed as the Manager of Court Reporters for the SC Judicial System. Her responsibility as described on that website is to assign court reporters to transcript orders. Enclosed is a copy of the website page with her name and job description, Exhibit 3.

The letter of October 10, 2024, requested that an official South Carolina Court Reporter employed by the state judicial system to complete the transcript of the WEBEX hearing of July 24, 2024, 1:30 p.m. docket before Judge B. Alex Hyman.

Today, with this letter I am making a second request that Ms. Holmes assign an official State of South Carolina court reporter who is employed by the SC Judicial System. A court reporter has 60 days to complete a transcript after the transcript has been assigned. As of today, there is no record of her assigning this to an official SC Court Reporter. There is no justification for her failure to assign this to an official court reporter. If there was justification, it is her responsibility to report that to me by letter or email. Refusing to assign the transcript as requested, is obstruction of justice.

This transcript was previously requested. It was sent to an e-service called Legal Eagles managed by a Kevin Dehlinger. I received a horrendous mess of a transcript from them by email. It appeared that the person who typed it had English as a foreign language. It took me 14 hours to figure out what it said. It was a 25 page transcript. Enclosed in Ms. Holmes letter is a copy of that pathetic (unreadable) transcript. It appears to have been transcribed by someone who has learned English as a foreign language and has no familiarity with the terminology of the court.

Please work with Ms. Holmes to meet the requirements of SCAC Rule 207.

THE LINE/DATE NOTATIONS DO NOT MATCH THE HOVER NOTATIONS, AND THE DOCUMENTS APPEARING WHEN THE HOVER LINE IS ACTIVATED DO NOT MATCH EITHER ONE.

AS I STUDIED THESE, BETWEEN 10:00 A.M. AND 10:40 A.M.

- 1) THE DOCUMENTS ATTACHED TO EACH LINE CHANGED AND
- 2) THE KITCHING LETTER OF DECEMBER 12, 2024, WAS REMOVED ENTIRELY.

I HAVE MADE A CHART OF THESE TO KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE AND WILL LET YOU KNOW IF THEY CHANGE, AGAIN. NEEDLESS TO SAY, THIS CAUSES MUCH CONFUSION WITH THE RECORD ON THIS CASE, AND COULD POSSIBLY BE USED TO SABOTAGE THIS CASE.
