MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Brandon Wilson respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until February 14, 2025**, in which to serve and file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Brandon Wilson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of

extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Dennis Cumbee with the Supreme Court on December 23, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Randy Chestnut v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 20, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter and record on appeal in the case of The State v. Tyshawn Cornelius Robinson with the Court of Appeals on December 12, 2024. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Willie M. Williams v. The State before the Court of Appeals on December 5, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Terrance Seabrook v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 25, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter and record on appeal in the case of The State v. Toya Danielle Steward with the Court of Appeals on November 22, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Francisco Rodriguez with the Supreme Court on November 21, 2024. Counsel filed the reply brief of petitioner in the case of Maurio D. Rivers v. The State with the Court of Appeals on November 7, 2024.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty-day general consent granted by email from Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka dated December 31, 2024 for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 31, 2025.
