Dear Ms. Kitchings,

This case is set for oral argument on Tuesday, February 11, 2025, at noon. In preparing for oral argument, I note a small, but nonetheless confusing, error in our August 9, 2023, Reply Brief to the Charleston Carriage Horse Advocates. On page 1, I wrote:

Respondent removed the action on July 19, 2018, and Appellant dismissed the federal court action four days later on July 13, 2018.

The “13” should be “23” and the sentence should read:

Respondent removed the action on July 19, 2018, and Appellant dismissed the federal court action four days later on July 23, 2018.

Despite the context, “four days later,” being clear, I want to correct this error ahead of oral argument. (I do not think the timeline of initial filings is important, but in the interest of precision, the timeline is: Appellant filed suit on May 29, 2018, at Case No. 2018-CP-10-2704. On July 19, 2018, Respondents filed a Notice of Removal to federal court at Case No. 2:18-cv-01980-RMG. On July 23, 2018, Appellant filed a Motion to Remand to State Court along with a Notice of Dismissal of the federal causes of action (ECF 5 and 6). On August 15, 2018, Appellant filed a Notice of Dismissal on the entire case (ECF 14) and refiled on August 17, 2018, at Case No. 2018-CP-10-4083, which is the case now before the Court.
