He advised my family of my case's ruling and advised them he would contact me with the correspondence of the hearing and speak with me about it, that was on April 7. It is now a new year, and I still have not gotten anything from him. My then counsel, Arthur Aiken advised that he file an appeal on my behalf as well. I have not gotten any notification of that either. My family continuously reaches out to him because I cannot being that I am incarcerated. He does not return their messages or take their calls, I assume because he feels he was paid for the PCR and maybe that his job is done. But as I said I have not got any verification of the appeal. I have contacted my county, they advised to speak with counsel. I have sent information to Mr. Aiken through the county which was verified and he still will not contact me. I contacted an appellate lawyer, and she advised me to contact Mr. Aiken. I tried the court of appeals, my county, the judge, the county where the hearing was, and even the prosecution all in the hopes of remedying this situation, but I can't get any responses. So I am hoping this letter is met with vigor of justice that I am supposed to be afforded by the judicial system.
