**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO RESPONDENT'S MOTION  
TO STRIKE AND REQUIRE FILING OF AMENDED RECORD ON APPEAL**

The Appellant, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves this Court for a ten (10) day extension of time to respond to the Respondent's Motion to Strike. In support of this motion, the Appellant states as follows:

1. The Appellant's response to the Respondent's Motion to Strike is currently due on **January 23, 2025**, pursuant to this Court's prior order granting an extension.
2. Due to inclement weather caused by a severe ice storm, the undersigned's office, located in Dorchester County, remains closed. Dorchester County was among the areas most severely impacted by the storm, making it unsafe for counsel and staff to work at the office or access necessary resources to prepare a response.
3. The undersigned is requesting a ten (10) day extension of time, moving the due date from **January 23, 2025, to February 3, 2025**, as the previously calculated date of February 2, 2025, falls on a Sunday.
4. This motion is not made for purposes of delay but is necessary to ensure the Appellant can prepare a thorough and complete response despite the unforeseen office closure caused by the ice storm. The Appellant also respectfully requests that all deadlines associated with this matter be held in abeyance until the Court has ruled on the present motion.

WHEREFORE, the Appellant respectfully requests that this Court grant a ten (10) day extension of time, until **February 3, 2025**, to file and serve the response to the Respondent's Motion to Strike and grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
