Howard was notified in response to my case on file. She has given me grounds to extend the time of limitation by counsel in Miller v. State 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010) James v. The case show I have grounds to support argument raised in the 12th Circuit of General Sessions. Brad Parkan raised the issue but didn't have the paperwork to cover the matter. The argument was based on the 7 years I was to receive and the time already served and the judges order Terry Weston that I wouldn't have to serve time in South Carolina for being a over length prison timer. ~~It~~ covers grounds on mandatory sentences over length time of prison time served. My attorney Brad Parkan was ineffective because of the prepetition clause, and Constitutional law of ~~service~~ ^{service} when the law was on file with the Appeals Court in Richmond V.A.

Also check into matters where I served 311 days + 75 days between Florence County Detention time and Kirkland R&E time. This is a total of 1 year and 21 days towards the 7 year sentence too Nov. 4, 2024. I haven't gotten the hearing mandata I requested but it was requested please do a follow up on that.
