**RESPONDENT’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE A REPLY TO RETURN TO PETITION FOR REHEARING**

Pursuant to Rule 240(a) and Rule 263(b), SCACR, Respondent Gibbs International, Inc.’s (“Respondent”) respectfully requests an extension of time of five (5) days within which to file Respondent’s Reply to the Return to the Petition for Rehearing filed by Appellants Sarmad Harake and Eurosa, Inc. (collectively, “Appellants”).

Appellants filed their Return to Respondent’s Petition for Rehearing on Thursday, January 23, 2025. Pursuant to Rule 240(f), SCACR, Respondent’s current deadline to file a Reply to Appellants’ Return to the Petition for Rehearing is Thursday, January 30, 2025.
