

## ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order denying the plaintiff's motion to strike a part of the defendant's answer. The appeal is dismissed as not immediately appealable. *See* S.C. Code Ann. §14-3-330 (2017) (setting forth the types of judgments and orders for which this Court has appellate jurisdiction); *Jefferson v. Gene's Used Cars, Inc.*, 295 S.C. 317, 318, 368 S.E.2d 456, 456 (1988) (noting an order where the judge did not strike the answer but refused to allow its filing is not immediately appealable); *Baldwin Constr. Co. v. Graham*, 357 S.C. 227, 230, 593 S.E.2d 146, 147 (2004) (dismissing appeal from an order refusing to rule on the substantive contents of an answer, refusing to strike a pleading, and refusing to allow late filing). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
