

Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Daniel J. Reed v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 20, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the case of Mitchell Rivers v. State with the Supreme Court on December 16, 2024. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Holly Jo Thompson v. State in the Court of Appeals on December 3, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Vincent Missouri v. 3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




