

ORDER

On December 10, 2024, Respondents moved to dismiss this appeal, alleging Appellants engaged in dilatory conduct. Appellants did not file a return. After careful consideration, we deny Respondents' motion to dismiss.

On November 5, 2024, Appellants filed a motion to extend the time for filing and serving their initial brief and designation of matter. Specifically, Appellants asked for an extension of thirty days. Respondents filed a return, opposing the request for an extension of time; in the alternative, Respondents asked that the court limit any extension of time to fourteen days. After careful consideration of the filings, we grant Appellants' motion in part. We grant Appellants an extension of fifteen days from the date of this order to file and serve their initial brief and designation of matter. No further extensions will be granted absent extraordinary circumstances. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of the appeal.
