
Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter will confirm receipt of the Order filed September 5, 2013. The purpose of my motion was that, in addition to omitting several items that were designated to be included, the submitted records had documents presented in a disjointed and haphazard fashion. Pages from a transcript of one hearing were included in the middle of a transcript from an entirely different hearing. The index was incorrect and I provided what I believed to be a proper index to assist the Court.
