**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO RESPONDENT'S MOTION
TO STRIKE AND REQUIRE FILING OF AMENDED RECORD ON APPEAL**

The Appellant, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves this Court for a ten (10) day extension of time to respond to the Respondent's Motion to Strike. In support of this motion, the Appellant states as follows:
