MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days until October 30, 2013** in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court today, September 30, 2013.
2. Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted

and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. This case was assigned to appellate defender LaNelle Cantey DuRant. Undersigned counsel has been reassigned to handle the present case, effective August 15, 2013. On September 10, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Darrell Florez with the Court of Appeals. On September 6, 2013, counsel filed an initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Damon T. Brown with the Court of Appeals. On August 28, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Bobby McConnell with this Court. On August 26, 2013, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompany appendix in Robert Earle Ricketts v. State with this Court.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


