

ORDER

On October 23, 2024, this court ordered Appellant to file and serve his initial brief and designation of matter by November 26, 2024. Appellant filed and served his initial brief and designation of matter on December 2, 2024. On December 12, 2024, Respondent moved to dismiss this appeal because Appellant failed to serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter timely.
