Dear Honorable Judge

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to sincerely seek your understanding and forgiveness regarding a missed bond payment that occurred recently. I understand the importance of adhering to court orders and the responsibilities that come with them, and it is with a heavy heart that I explain my situation.

On the day the bond payment was due, my newborn baby was unexpectedly hospitalized due to a serious health issue. He had a rectal temperature of 103.00, and I was told to bring him in immediately for care because such temperatures for a newborn can be fatal if not handled immediately. This situation required my immediate attention and presence at the hospital, and I was assured by the medical staff that if the situation stabilized, it would allow me to handle the financial obligations the following morning.

Unfortunately, my fiancé, Jamar Stark, works out of state, throughout the week and is only home on weekends. So, the burden was mine and mine alone. I also have no immediate support system in the state of South Carolina that could have assisted me. I was open and communicative with Sumter Summary Court, calling multiple times, requesting assistance with the payment over the phone, unfortunately I was told there was no option for that request. I also requested to speak with a Judge who might be able to assist me, and was told "there is no Judge available to talk to you, just come in, in the morning, and make the payment then".

In good faith, I made the bond payment as soon as I was able, on February 6, 2025, only to encounter an unfortunate complication: the respondents have refused to accept my payment. This has left me feeling distressed and anxious, as I genuinely intended to fulfill my obligations. I understand that circumstances do not excuse my oversight, but I hope you can forgive me for this unforeseen situation that led to the delay. I am committed to rectifying this matter and ensuring that I remain compliant with all court orders moving forward. I respectfully ask for your

compassion and understanding in this matter, as I navigate this challenging time for both myself and my family.

I would like to request that the motion to stay remain in place, as we proceed in our appeal. We have made the bond payment on time, consistently for the time it has been in place since April of 2023.

Thank you for considering my request. I appreciate your time and attention to this matter, and I hope to resolve it in a manner that reflects the values of fairness and understanding.

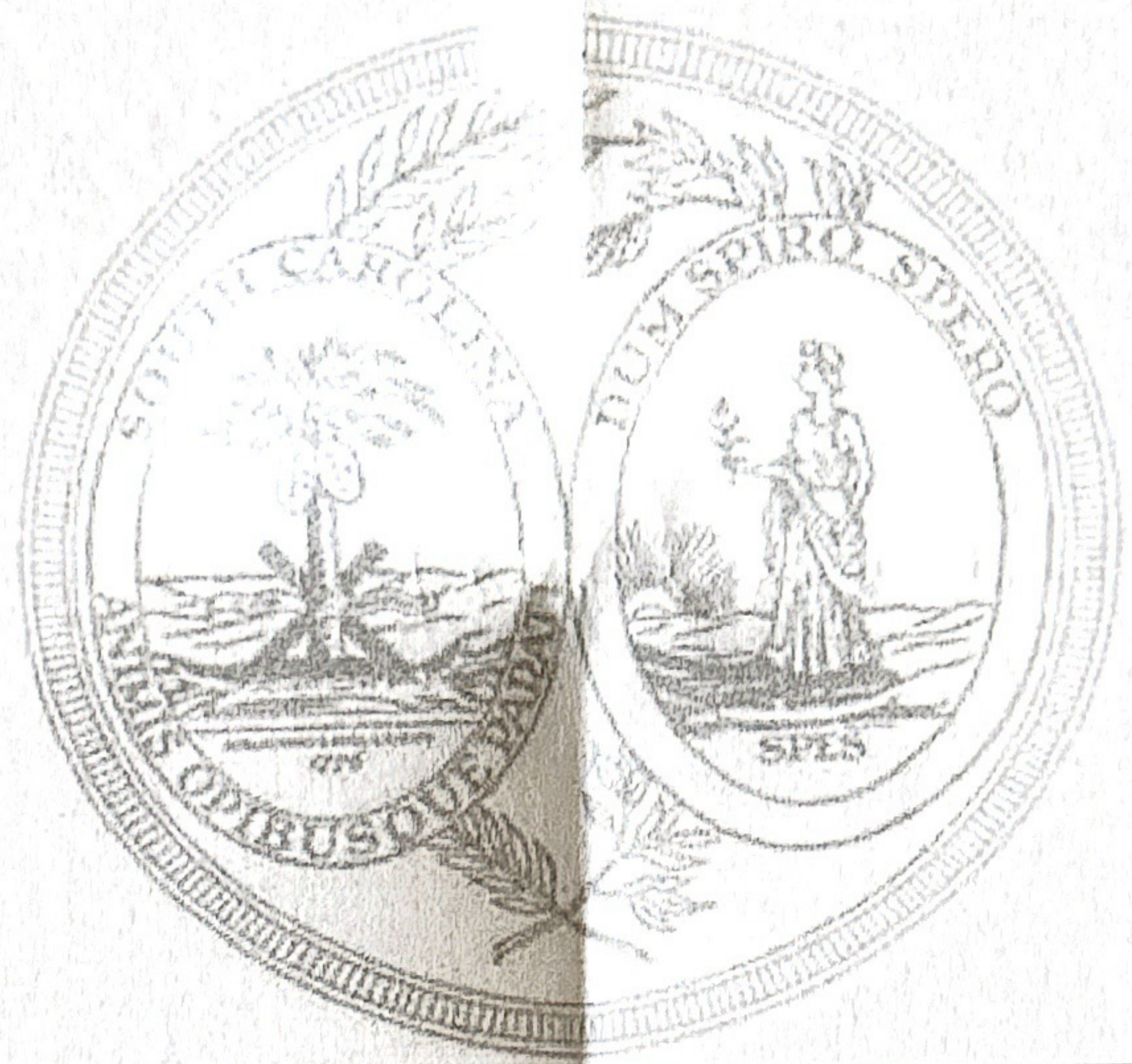
