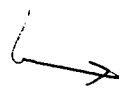

DEPUTIES INFORMED DISPATCH ON WHAT WAS GOING ON AND ALSO INFORMED LT. CRAIN THAT WE NEEDED ASSISTANCE DUE TO THE INFORMATION GIVEN TO US ON THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE SUPPOSEDLY AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION. DEPUTY RHOADES, TAMMONG, GARRISON, SGT. JOURTAL AND LT. CRAIN RESPONDED TO THE SCENE FOR ASSISTANCE. ONCE ALL DEPUTIES LISTED ABOVE WERE ON SCENE A PLAN WAS FORMED AND WHILE APPROACHING THE LOCATION DEPUTIES OBSERVED A VEHICLE APPROACH THE LOCATION. DEPUTIES STOPPED THE VEHICLE AND FOUND A MRS. JEAN PARKER DRIVING. MRS. PARKER LIVED AT THE RESIDENCE AND GAVE THE DEPUTIES CONSENT TO COME ON THE PROPERTY AND CHECK THE SCENE FOR THE VICTIM. LT. CRAIN ADVISED DEPUTIES TO PUT MRS. PARKER IN INVESTIGATIVE DETENTION UNTIL THE SCENE WAS SECURE. DEPUTIES THEN APPROACHED THE INCIDENT LOCATION WITH EXTREME CAUTION DUE TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES GIVEN TO US WHEN DEPUTIES APPROACHED THE RESIDENCE OFFICERS ANNOUNCED THEIR PRESENCE AND THREE INDIVIDUALS CAME OUT OF THE CAMPER.
