

ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the Administrative Law Court dismissing Appellant's appeal from his Step 2 grievance requesting to be paid the prevailing wage for his work as an inmate. Respondent filed a motion to dismiss the appeal as moot, and Appellant filed a return objecting to the dismissal. After careful consideration, the motion to dismiss is denied without prejudice. Respondent may argue this issue in their initial brief and Appellant may respond in his initial reply brief. Respondent's initial brief and designation of matter are due to be served and filed within 30 days of the date of this order. Nothing in this order prohibits Respondent from seeking permission from this Court to remand the appeal for issuance of a new final agency decision. *See* Rule 205, SCACR (providing upon service of a notice of appeal, the appellate court shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the appeal).
