Dear Mr. Holtzclaw:

Upon reviewing your correspondence filed December 20, 2024, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed. This is the Court's second request for these corrections:

- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- You must provide proof of filing a copy of your notice of appeal with the clerk of the lower court.
- You must serve and file a notice of appeal that is substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

Furthermore, we are in receipt of your correspondence filed on January 24, 2025. If you wish to request relief from this Court, you must do so in the form of a motion pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR. No further action will be taken on your correspondence.
