Please consider this a formal request for a Reconsideration of the January 14, 2025 Order denying certiorari in the above-referenced matter.


It appears that significant facts have been overlooked in the consideration of this matter. First, I timely filed a notice of appeal from the Administrative Law Court. I also filed a motion to proceed in forma pauperis within seven (7) days thereof. After a few weeks the Court wrote and said they had an in forma pauperis motion but that I had not filed a notice of appeal. I wrote and explained I had. They wrote and said I had not. I filed a second Notice of Appeal accompanied by a copy of the ALC order and a certificate of service on all parties required by Court Rules. Approximately one (1) week later my original Notice of Appeal package was returned to me here at the institution marked as "undeliverable." I immediately wrote the Court of Appeals with an explanation. The error was I wrote the wrong last digit of the Post Office Box number. I even enclosed the original envelope to show the post mark was timely. That postmarked envelope should be in the Clerk's Office of the Court of Appeals. The Court of Appeals denied the appeal as untimely.

You can literally write "Clerk of Court of Lexington County" with no street address, just Lexington, South Carolina, and it will be delivered. This is so in any County in South Carolina. The Post Office had to see the address was the Court of Appeals.

This is truly a scrivener error that should not be held to deprive me of my due process rights. I was diligent in the litigation of this case since filing the Step 1 Grievance in 2011 and have never missed a deadline.

I implore the Court to reconsider the circumstances of this matter and grant certiorari so the appeal may be heard. I was not sitting on my rights.

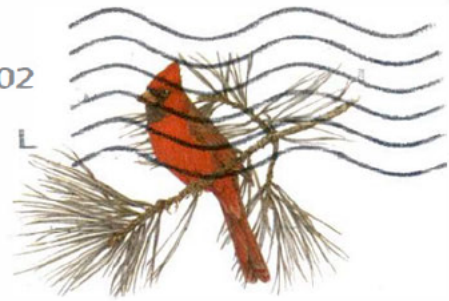
