ORDER

On December 2, 2024, Appellant filed his final brief and the record on appeal. On December 10, 2024, Appellant filed an amended record on appeal. On December 11, 2024, Respondents filed a motion to dismiss the appeal, or in the alternative, to compel Appellant to comply with Rules 210 and 211 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Appellant did not file a return. After careful consideration, we deny Respondents' motion to dismiss. However, we strike Appellant's final brief, the record on appeal filed on December 2, 2024, and the record on appeal filed December 10, 2024. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file a second amended record on appeal that includes all matters designated by the parties. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party . . . "). At that same time, and pursuant to Rule 211(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellant shall serve and file an amended Appellant's brief that is identical to Appellant's initial brief with the only exceptions being corrections of typographical errors and the insertion of citations to the record on appeal. Appellant's failure to comply with this order will result in the dismissal of the appeal.
