Notice of Appeal

The Appellant was convicted of SCDC Rules infraction: 897 "Possession of security Equipment/property" on November 19, 2012. The Appellant filed his first step Grievance and received disposition on December 3, 2012. Subsequently, the Appellant filed his second step grievance and received the final agency decision on January 7, 2013. After denial, the Appellant filed his Appeal with the Administrative Law Court and received an order of Dismissal from John D. McLeod on August 20, 2013, for failure to separate his arguments and paragraphs properly pursuant to Rule 60 SCARC, special Appeals. This Appeal follows: The Appellant lost 45-days statutorily mandated good time credits creating the loss of a protected liberty interest and entitling him to Due process. Further, the Disciplinary hearing officer created an Abuse of Discretion by finding the Appellant guilty of the above mentioned Rules infraction as the Evidence doesn't support the conviction or decision. The Counsel Substitute was ineffective. The written statement of the fact-finders wasn't properly completed as mandated by S.CDC policy op.22.14.

prejudicing the Appellant from calling witnesses that would have effectively changed the out-come of his Hearing. Lastly, the Disciplinary hearing officer did not follow the SCDC's policy and guidelines.
