 This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff Goldie Reeves' Motion to Vacate Arbitration Award. Ms. Reeves filed this motion pro se although she is represented by Mr. Lee Daniels, Jr.

Pursuant to Section 15-48-130 of the South Carolina Code, a Court may vacate an arbitration award if it finds that the award was procured through fraud or corruption; the arbitrator exceeded their powers; an arbitrator refused to hear relevant evidence or otherwise conducted arbitration in a means to prejudice a party; or there was no arbitration agreement. Pursuant to Section 15-48-140 of the South Carolina Code, a Court may modify an arbitration award if there was an evident mistake or miscalculation; arbitrators have made an award on an issue not submitted to them; or an award is imperfect in matter of form only.

Ms. Reeves has not alleged any statutory grounds that would allow this Court to vacate or modify the arbitration award. Further, Ms. Reeves was represented by competent counsel and a Guardian Ad Litem at the arbitration and this Court has no reason to doubt that her interests were protected. As such, this Court denies Plaintiff's Motion to Vacate.


