Counsel for Terrance Wing respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension from February 21, 2025 until March 24, 2025 in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Natalia Chisolm v. State with the Supreme Court on February 19, 2025. Counsel filed the

Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Nick Evangelista v. State with the Supreme Court on February 14, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of In the Interest of Khalid J., A Juvenile Under the Age of Seventeen before the Court of Appeals on February 11, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Tiffany R. Owens with the Court of Appeals on February 3, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Terry Gridine with the Court of Appeals on January 23, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Reply Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Travontae Mitchell with the Court of Appeals on January 13, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


